WHAT'S IN YOUR TOOLBOX?

Accuracy: 1/16 inch or 1mm
 Tape length: 16 Feet / 4.8768 Meters
 Tape blade width: 3/4 inch
 Battery: CR2032 Lithium (included)
 Turn off: automatic - 5 minutes
 Turn on: Pull blade
 Measurement units Feet, Inches, Fractions, to 1/16th of an inch (ex. 2' 7 3/16")

Inches, Fractions, to 1/16th of an inch (ex. 31 3/16") Decimal Inches, to 1/10th of an inch (ex. 31.1") Decimal Feet, to 1/100th of a foot (ex. 2.59') Centimeters, to 1/10 of a Centimeter (ex. 79.1 cm)

I think that this is the coolest measuring tape out there.
